Princeton offers a diversity of public parks: **Princeton City Park**, home of the famous Princeton Flea Market; beautiful **Megow Park** located on Water Street with the Fox River flowing behind it; **Hiestand Park** on the banks of the Fox River; **Old Mill Park**, with picnic tables and fun for kids; and the **Lions Park** with newly renovated tennis courts.



Launch your boat into the Fox River at **Hiestand Park** just off Hwy 23/73 on Mechanic Street. A newly installed handicap accessible EZ Launch[™] transfer system allows users to easily enter and leave the water with kayaks or canoes. Boats can also be launched at the **Princeton Dam** on Lock Road or at the **White River Dam** 3 miles east of Princeton off County Road J on Huckleberry Road.

Princeton is also home to a gorgeous, brand new Public Library nearly doubling the space of the previous building. Stop in today and check it out! They are located at 424 W. Water Street, right in the heart of downtown Princeton.
