A recently installed handicap accessible EZ Launch™ transfer system allows users to easily enter and leave the water with kayaks or canoes. Boats can also be launched at the **Princeton Dam** on Lock Road or at the **White River Dam** 3 miles east of Princeton off County Road J on Huckleberry Road.

Princeton is also home to a gorgeous, brand new Public Library nearly doubling the space of the previous building. They offer free children's activities, public computers, Wi-Fi, and meeting rooms.
