



Take your time and discover the beauty of central Wisconsin and spend a week in Princeton. Stay at one of our local campgrounds, motels, or Airbnbs. Reacquaint yourself with nature. Teach your kids how to canoe, while discovering the historic Fox River. Relish the peace and quiet while spending the day golfing, fishing or hunting. Look back in time and enjoy the slow, sweet pace of small town life. Take Princeton's Historical Walking Tour or visit a cemetery reenactment.

And when you want to explore some more, take a tour of a local winery or family farm, and savor the taste of food and drink, crafted by real people just for you. Make sure to bring your bikes and traverse one of the eight bike paths stretching out through the hills and woods of the surrounding area. And there is a winter wonderland waiting for you in Princeton with our snowmobiling trails, ice skating, and cross-country skiing.

PEDAL PRINCETON BACKROADS

Just park your car in the downtown parking lot and head out to explore the backroads on eight scenic bike tours offering backroad cycling experiences for all types of riders. Take along a detailed map available throughout town.



WINTER OUTDOOR FUN

Miles of manicured snowmobile trails take you for short hops or daylong excursions from county to county. Relax in the winter woods while cross-country skiing. Beautifully maintained trails for all levels of skiers abound in the Princeton area.



Ice fishing, in and around the Princeton area, offers great winter action for Lake Trout, Panfish (Bluegill, Crappie, Perch), Walleye, Northern Pike, and Cisco, especially on Big Green Lake, Puckaway, and Little Green. The season runs from December to March, but make sure the ice is safe before heading out.

AMISH

Amish country is only minutes from Princeton in the Grand River Marsh area. Glimpse a lifestyle steeped in tradition and simplicity. Delight in fine craftsmanship as each homestead dedicates itself to their specialty and opens their doors to you.



Princeton offers a diversity of public parks: **Princeton City Park**, home of the famous Princeton Flea Market; beautiful **Megow Park** located on Water Street with the Fox River flowing behind it; **Hiestand Park** on the banks of the Fox River; **Old Mill Park**, with picnic tables and fun for kids; and the **Lions Park** with newly renovated tennis courts.



Launch your boat into the Fox River at **Hiestand Park** just off Hwys 23/73 on Mechanic Street. A recently installed handicap accessible EZ Launch™ transfer system allows users to easily enter and leave the water with kayaks or canoes. Boats can also be launched at the **Princeton Dam** on Lock Road or at the **White River Dam** 3 miles east of Princeton off County Road J on Huckleberry Road.

Princeton is also home to a gorgeous, brand new Public Library nearly doubling the space of the previous building. They offer free children's activities, public computers, Wi-Fi, and meeting rooms. Stop in today and check it out! They are located at 424 W. Water Street, right in the heart of downtown Princeton.






